The palace and its grounds are a UNESCO Heritage Site. It was the seat of the Korean Royal Family and has been part of the country's history for centuries. It was built shortly after <u>Gyeonbokgung Palace</u>, in 1405. In 1592 it was set on fire by angry

Seoulites when the royals fled the city after a Japanese invasion. It was restored in 1611 and nowadays it is a museum. It is one of Seoul's top tourist attractions and expect to see crowds and lines in high season. The best time to visit is in Spring or Autumn, when the vegetation adds more color to the scenery.

If you want to visit the Secret Garden, you will need to join a guided tour and the ticket is a little more expensive. Nevertheless, just walking around the area and the main patios is worth the visit. Around the palace's wall and in the streets leading to Gyeonbokgung Palace there are small craft shops, cafés, traditional restaurants and a slower paced atmosphere.

During the centuries it has grown, parts of it have been destroyed, others rebuilt, but it has remained a focus of the Korean spirit and national identity. It is a massive area, with temples, gates, bridges and museums. The ceremony of the changing of the guard happens daily on the hour from 10am to 3pm. It is very colorful and the costumes look impressive. Plan your visit for a nice sunny day and avoid going during the freezing winter months as it gets awfully cold and windy.

Occupying one whole block of Apgujeong street in Gangnam area, BoonTheShop is probably Seoul's most stylish shop selling a myriad of fashion brands from the world over. The structure itself, signed by Peter Marino Architects from New York, is already impressive, with high white walls, glass and concrete. The multi-floor space has excellent and well thought of displays.

(https://veroinn.com/) The mix of clothes, shoes and accessories is curated and there is more of a style than at the 10 Corso Como, just a block away. Their café and restaurant, Rubrica, on the 4th floor, are also very nice, with beautiful looking cakes and pastries. The Seoulite high-society meets there.

The second is a contemporary art space with both rotating and permanent exhibitions. In one of the staircases there is an Olafur Eliasson piece occupying the whole area.
